This collection of forty activities will help people of all ages explore and experience seven significant periods of the liturgical cycle: Advent, Christmas, Epiphany, Lent, Easter, Pentecost, and Ordinary Time as well as the Church Year as a whole. Each chapter features a period, offering one learning center activity for each of the five senses. Use them in classrooms, for family or intergenerational events, in worship settings such as Children's Church or Children's Liturgy of the Word, or for many other experiences.

These creative activities will remind learners to get ready for the Messiah during Advent, celebrate the birth of the Savior at Christmas, rejoice in God's gift of the Christ Child throughout Epiphany, remember the life and ministry of Jesus in Lent, commemorate the Savior's death and resurrection at Easter, share the Good News of God's love during Pentecost, and grow as disciples throughout Ordinary Time.
